SUBJECT: Missouri Highway Patrol Vehicle Purchase

**DISCUSSION:** The East Peoria Police Department has an aging fleet and needs newer replacement vehicles for patrol. The department has contacted the Missouri Highway Patrol Fleet Sales and received pricing on their used fleet vehicles. We would purchase (4) 2018 Ford Explorers at \$22,500 each totaling \$90,000. Currently owned equipment will be used to upfit the vehicles as much as possible to reduce the expenses of upfitting.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approval of request to purchase four vehicles from the Missouri Highway Patrol for active fleet use.

**WHEREAS**, currently owned equipment will be used to outfit the Vehicles as much as possible to reduce additional unplanned expenses for outfitting the Vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the City to purchase the Vehicles from the Missouri Highway Patrol in an amount not to exceed \$90,000.00;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST PEORIA, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The above recitations are found to be true and correct.

**Section 2.** The purchase of the Vehicles is hereby approved, and the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Missouri Highway Patrol for an amount not to exceed \$90,000.00 for purchasing the Vehicles on behalf of the City's Police Department, together with such changes as the Mayor in his discretion may approve; provided, however, that the City shall have no obligation under the terms of this Resolution to the Missouri Highway Patrol until an original purchase order or agreement has been delivered to the Missouri Highway Patrol.
