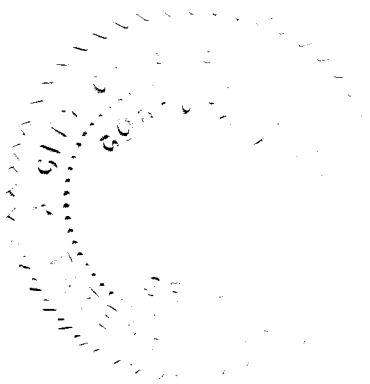
WHEREAS, the world, the nation, and the State of Illinois observe Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month in April 2021; and
