SUBJECT: Petition of Michael Richardson for a Special Use to allow an accessory structure larger and taller than permitted by code on property located at 605 Illini Drive 01-01-26-300-018.

BACKGROUND: The proposal here is for an approximately 2,000 sf accessory structure to house the petitioner's work vehicle and to facilitate gatherings of family and friends. The façade will be complementary to the home but in warmer months, it won't be very visible, if at all, from the street. The height of the building is not to exceed 20'.

At their meeting, the ZBA 5-0 to recommend this Special Use, as presented.

ORDINANCE NO. 4605

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL USE
FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 605 ILLINI DRIVE
IN THE CITY OF EAST PEORIA, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, Michael Richardson (the "Petitioner") has petitioned for a special use for an oversized accessory building on his property zoned "R-2 One-Family Dwelling District" and located at 605 Illini Drive in East Peoria, as shown and described at "Exhibit A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (which property as so described hereinafter referred to as the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, after hearing pursuant to duly published notice, the East Peoria Zoning Board of Appeals has recommended approval of the proposed Special Use subject to certain conditions hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST PEORIA, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1. A Special Use to allow for placement of an oversized accessory structure on the Property is hereby approved.

Section 2. The establishment and continuation of the special use hereby authorized is contingent upon continual compliance with all applicable provisions of the City Code and the following special conditions:

1. The accessory structure authorized by this Ordinance shall be no larger than the approximately 2,000 square foot sized structure as presented to the Zoning Board of Appeals.
2. The accessory structure authorized by this Ordinance shall not exceed 20 feet in height.
3. The accessory structure authorized by this Ordinance shall have a façade that is complimentary to the primary structure on the Property.

Upon the violation of or failure to comply with the foregoing conditions or with any provisions of the City Code applicable to the Property or its use, the City Council may, after providing reasonable notice and an opportunity for a hearing, terminate the Special Use hereby approved.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby ordered to be published in pamphlet form by the East Peoria City Clerk and said Clerk is ordered to keep at least three (3) copies hereof available for public inspection in the future and in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is in addition to all other ordinances on the subject and shall be construed therewith excepting as to that part in direct conflict with any other ordinance, and in the event of such conflict, the provisions hereof shall govern.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and ten (10) day period of publication in the manner provided by law.
