SUBJECT: RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE THE ATTACHED QUOTE FROM KRUMHOLZ BROTHERS LANDSCAPING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,000.00 FOR INSTALLING EROSION CONTROL AT THE OUTFALL END OF THE STORM SEWER PIPE TRAVERSING UNDER GRANGE RD IN ANTICIPATION OF A LARGER SCALE ROADWAY PROJECT TAKING PLACE THIS SUMMER.

DISCUSSION:

As part of the upcoming Grange Rd roadway improvements expected to be completed this summer it is necessary to address drainage erosion at the outfall end of a drainage structure under the roadway prior to performing roadway work.

There is currently a box culvert structure running under Grange Rd. in need of erosion control in the form of gabion concrete filled basket walls and mattress lining.

Work will include all necessary material, workmanship and labor to complete this project. Five quotes were solicited with four contractors' bids ranging from \$139,900.00 to \$23,000. Each contractor prepared different means and methods to address the erosion. The contractor being recommended has provided the most economical fix fitting our needs.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the attached estimate submitted by Krumholz Brothers Landscaping, Inc in the amount of \$23,000.00 for the above-mentioned repairs to be paid for using General Street Funds, 011-00-0-055.

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING PROPOSAL FROM KRUMHOLZ BROTHERS LANDSCAPING, INC. FOR THE GRANGE ROAD STORM WATER DRAINAGE OUTFALL EROSION CONTROL PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City will be undertaking needed roadway repairs and improvements to Grange Road that are expected to be completed this summer of 2023; and

WHEREAS, City Officials have identified needed storm water drainage repairs at the outfall end of a drainage structure under the roadway of Grange Road (the “Grange Road Outfall Erosion Control Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City solicited quotes from local contractors, receiving four bids; and

WHEREAS, City Officials recommend acceptance of the proposal from Krumholz Brothers Landscaping, Inc. (“Krumholz”) at a cost of \$23,000.00 under the terms and conditions set forth in the Proposal attached hereto as “Exhibit A” and incorporated by reference (the “Proposal”), as the Proposal is the most economical fix for the Grange Road Outfall Erosion Control Project from the bids received by the City, and

WHEREAS, the City hereby finds that this Proposal with Krumholz for undertaking the Grange Road Outfall Erosion Control Project is in the best interests of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST PEORIA, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitations are found to be true and correct.

Section 2. The Proposal from Krumholz for the Grange Road Outfall Erosion Control Project is accepted and approved.

Section 3. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Proposal with the Krumholz for the Grange Road Outfall Erosion Control Project on behalf of the City in the amount of \$23,000.00, together with such changes therein as the Mayor in his discretion deems appropriate; provided, however, that the City shall have no obligation under the contract with the Krumholz until such time as an executed original of such documentation has been delivered to the Krumholz.
